A high-yielding, high-quality, winterhardy four dormant variety with excellent disease resistance to enhance the production of dairy quality hay. 54Q32 will generally have better forage quality at a given date versus other alfalfa varieties, and can maintain better forage quality longer than most other varieties if harvest is delayed. Position 54Q32 where growers want high quality forage especially if harvest delays are frequent.

Management Comments¹

- Highly suitable to 3-4 cuts of high quantity & quality hay production.
- High suitability to diverse environments, especially where root rots are a concern.
- Good choice for growers who want to plant more than one variety, for extended harvest window
